

# Dinos and Dragons Monstrosity in Puppetry

Beginning October 3rd, 2018, enormous creatures from prehistory and mythology, will take possession of the Augsburg Puppet Theatre Museum „die Kiste“ and enchant its visitors, guaranteeing a museum visit to remember. Here, the dinosaurs, which died out millions of years ago, are brought back to life and can be admired in the form of various figures and natural history exhibits, as well as dragons and their stories, which are as fascinating as the creatures themselves. The special exhibition is intended to be a place for marvelling and learning, an experience to look at, touch and participate in. There are countless stories about dinosaurs, and very many stories with dragons can be found within the Bible, in Fairy Tales and legends, fantasy novels and children’s literature. All guests, children and adults, can have a look at a wide range of very small or extremely huge creatures - either eerily beautiful or enchantingly cute. Visit Urmel and his dinosaur and dragon friends from the „Augsburger Puppenkiste“, view exhibits, created by the puppet builder Norman Schneider, meet the table-top rod puppets from the Berlin-based „Theatre LaKritz“ and admire the wooden hand puppets from „Kreft’s Puppenbühne“ from Bargaen. During the special exhibition, international exhibits from the United States and Spain will also be on display in the Puppet Theatre Museum.
